There are some rocky fields and cliffs on the depressions' slopes.
Vegetation consists mostly of deciduous forest with occasional coniferous trees.
Runnability and visibility is mostly good. Running is sometime reduced due to a rocky ground and tree branches. There are some forest roads in the terrain and a medium density of the paths.
