

Bulletin 2 - Final information Slovak Championship in Knock-Out Sprint

Organizer: SLOVENSKÝ ZVÄZ ORIENTAČNÝCH ŠPORTOV

Technical realization: ŠK Farmaceut Bratislava

Date: 30.4.2023 (Sunday)

Event centre: sport areal near ZŠ Alexandra Dubčeka Majerníkova 62, Bratislava. (48.1560017N, 17.0478831E).

The school building is undergoing renovation work. The construction site is fenced. Please respect the guidelines for movement in the area of the school campus. The situation is constantly changing, it is impossible to describe it in advance. Thank you for your understanding.

Prohibited area: From 8.30 the entire area Dlhé diely (housing estate) except the sports areal ZŠ A. Dubčeka, Majerníkova 62 and main access road = Majerníkova street. Please follow the marked path to starts.

Classification: open daily individual Knock-out sprint race for categories:

M 16E, M 17E, M 40E, M 50E, M 60E, W 16E, W 17E, W 40E, W 50E, W 60E

The qualification is included in the SRJ with coefficient E in accordance with the competition rules for 2023.

Public categories: N - beginners (relatively easy course for beginners), K – fitness (orienteering more demanding course with a length of approximately 2km). Public categories have a standard one-lap race.

Registration: only Saturday 29.4.2023 from 10.00 to 12.00 in even centre SRJ sprint.

Maps: processed according to ISSprOM 2019-2, status: April 2023. Author: Pavol Bukovac. Printed on waterproof paper.

Special map symbols: black cross, circle - artificial object (playing, exercise or advertising element).

Start bibs: You will receive it at the registration. They will be valid for SRJ sprint on Saturday, and for MSR in KO sprint on Sunday. Competitors without starting numbers will not be allowed to start! In an exceptional case, if a competitor discovers before the MSR KO sprint race that he has

destroyed or lost the assigned start number during the race on Saturday, he has the chance to ask for a replacement of bib to be issued at the registration, or in the event centre office.

Predicted times of the winners: are according Slovak orienteering rules in the article 12.18.

Inaccessible or dangerous areas, prohibited tracks:

It is forbidden to cross roads marked in map by symbol 709 Out-of-bounds area

Crossing roads is allowed at marked crossings points. They are marked on the map by symbols 710.1 Crossing point and 710.2 Crossing section. The referees will supervise safety and compliance with the rules.

It is forbidden enter to areas marked by symbol 520 Area that shall not be entered (olive colour).

Terrain: at which level your control point is located.

Terrain: Residential development on a gentle slope with the occurrence of short, steeper slopes and stairs. Most of the terrain has never been used for orienteering.

Punching system: Contactless punching system Sport Ident Air+ enabling contactless punching up to distance of approx. 0.5 m.

Placement in semi-final groups: are according Slovak orienteering rules in the article E.4. except categories M17 a W17.

Competitors in categories M17 a W17 W17 are placed into the semi-finals groups according their own decisions during the public presentation of their decision at the time of approx. 10.45 - 11.15 at event centre. The competitor who achieved a better position in the qualification always has the right of priority selection.

The competitor with the best placement will be the first to choose the semi-final group A, B or C.

A tag with his / her name pine on the bulletin board under the letter of the selected group. The other competitors follow in the order given by their place in the qualification and gradually occupy the semi-final groups. The deployment model is taken from WOC 2022 in Denmark.

Rules, protests: The competition is governed by the Slovak Orienteering Rules and the Competition Rules for year 2023. Protests with a deposit of €10 to the main referee.

Jury: It will be formed, if necessary, on the spot from representatives of the clubs.

Results ceremony: within 30 minutes of the last start of final B.

Additional activity: Orienteering Labyrinth will be built at the event centre close to finish line.

Refreshment: tea or water with syrup after completing the course. We are asking the competitors to take the disposable cup as they need it only once. We recommend using your own glasses.
